This beautiful setting at the entrance to Puget Sound on the northeast corner of the Olympic Peninsula combines breathtaking views of mountains and sea. The park is adjacent to the quaint Victorian town of Port Townsend, about 50 miles from Seattle. The full workshop registration includes a Friday evening dance, the Saturday classes, a Saturday evening Ball and champagne party, and Sunday morning dancing. A retreat option includes everything except the Saturday classes. We welcome dancers with at least six months of SCD experience. **Please note there has been a change in our Friday night musicians.** Ken Natrass and Ron Krug are unable to join us as previously planned but we are very fortunate to have the talented team of Ryan McKasson and Cali McKasson Covin agree to step in. DORMITORY: Small rooms with a twin bed. There are some larger rooms with two twin beds. Bathrooms are down the hall. Cooking is not permitted so price includes four meals (three on Saturday plus Sunday breakfast) in the cafeteria. **Linen service is no longer optional and is included in the dormitory price.**

VACATION HOUSING: Shared houses have a parlor, dining room, fully equipped kitchen and multiple bedrooms with linen and daily maid service. These consist of the larger Officers' Row houses (3-6 bedrooms) and the smaller NCO houses (2 bedrooms). Most bedrooms have a queen size bed; some have two twin beds (one room of each NCO house and a very few in Officers' Row); and there are some small single twin bed rooms in the large houses. One rollaway bed is available in each house.
